
- Ensure harmony prevails between the Most Excellent Grand Chapter Holy Royal Arch Masons and the North Carolina Grand Court Heroines of Jericho



RIGHT EXCELLENT GRAND SECRETARY


- Ensure all forms are up to date and communications are sent out in a timely manner.

RIGHT EXCELLENT GRAND TRUSTEES

- Complete and Inventory List of all Property, Equipment and Regalia belonging to the Grand Chapter, provide a copy to the MEGHP and REG Secretary.
- Locate and identify who is in possession of property not stored at the Grand Lodge
- Identify items in need of replacement and those we need to purchase for the MEGCHRAMNC, Inc
- Ensure Grand Chapter property, equipment and regalia are onsite for the Grand Convocation in partnership with the Grand Trustees of the PHGCRSMNC and the THGCKT, that inventoried and returned to the Grand Lodge storage area after the close of the session.

GRAND LECTURER /ASSISTANT GRAND LECTURER


- Promote ritualistic uniformity compliance and excellence.



- Coordinate Chapter visitations with the District Lecturer
- Identify Chapters needing assistance with membership or administrative matters.
- Review and forward all requests for Dispensations from Chapters to the MEGHP for approval.
- Conduct Chapter elections or identify a PEHP to perform this duty and notify the MEGHP of your choice.
- Ensure Chapter Reports are completed and mailed to Grand
 Secretary before <u>15 January</u> with separate checks for the following: Taxes, Benevolence, Scholarship Donations and Order of the High Priesthood.

EXCELLENT HIGH PRIESTS


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
- Use your utmost endeavors to preserve peace and harmony your Chapter and by your own deportment, both within and without the chapter, to be a good example to your Companions

- Appoint a conservation committee in October to visit and call upon members who are not attending the meetings.

GENERAL INFORMATION


- The Royal Arch Capitular/fiscal year is **01 January** to **31 December**.
- Members can only be suspended from the roll for non-payment of dues by vote of the members present at the December Chapter meeting.



- All Chapters are required to maintain a P.O. Box for all correspondence sent by the MEGCHRAMNC, Inc.
- All Chapters should explore obtaining a Life membership in the NAACP and encourage all members to get memberships in their local Branches.
- All Chapters should work to become proficient in degree work to include Royal Arch Burial Rites.
- Host a minimum of one (2) community service projects working with the homeless shelters (Men and women), making quarterly donations to your local food banks.
- Visitation among Chapters is strongly encouraged and supported.
- Three principal officers of the Chapter should register and attend Grand Convocation and represent their chapter.
- District Meetings are open to all members unless otherwise noted in writing. Executive Board meetings are open to all members unless otherwise noted in writing.
- Dispensation Requests are needed for:



- Any event where Royal Arch Regalia will be worn other than a regular meeting or Last Rites Ceremonies
- Arching of Companions
- Church Visitations / Public Events
- Change of Meeting Dates / Change of Meeting Locations (Temporary or Permanent)
- Community Service and fundraiser functions
- Dispensation Requests should be submitted to the District Deputy at least 30 days in advance and he will forward to the office of the Most Excellent Grand High Priest
- Chapters should not wait until the end of the year to submit reports on membership changes; supplemental reports should be done no later than 30 days after the change takes place.
- All website information should be sent to the Grand Secretary, and he will forward to the Webmaster.
- All chapters must order their rituals, Marks, Constitution and Bylaws through the Grand Secretary's office, so that we may keep our work in the State of North Carolina uniform.



- Information for the Stone Squarer is due to the Most Excellent Grand High Priest/Grand Newsletter Editor no later than the 15th of the following months (April/July/October).
